

Case study: Activities to Recover the Number of Salmon Runs in the Rivers of the Nooksack Region of the U.S.

Trans-Ocean Products Inc. participates in environmental conservation activities to recover the number of salmon runs in the spawning region of Whatcom County, Washington with the nonprofit Nooksack Salmon Enhancement Association (<https://www.n-sea.org/>) through activities at least once a month.

In December 2021, non-native plant species were eliminated and native species were planted along the banks of the Squalicum River, which runs behind the plant facilities of Trans-Ocean Products Inc.
